

[Important Notice] Train Timetable Change

We are pleased to announce *a partial update to our train schedule starting Saturday, March 14, 2026*. This revision aims to enhance travel convenience for sightseeing by increasing Limited Express Romancecar services, introducing longer train configurations, and improving connections. A major highlight is the return of our fastest service after two years: the "Super Hakone No. 5" (departing Shinjuku at 9:00 AM on weekends and holidays) will once again connect Shinjuku and Odawara in just 59 minutes.

Important updates

1. Weekday Limited Express Romancecar Services

1.1 Morning service increase: Two new Limited Express Romancecar services will be added to the morning schedule.

Train type	Destination
Enoshima No. 1	Shinjuku (7:10) → Fujisawa (8:03)
Sagami No. 93	Shinjuku (7:18) → Isehara (8:12)

1.2 Evening Enhancements: We are adding more stops, using longer trains, and improving connections for a smoother evening commute.

2. Weekend & Holiday Limited Express Romancecar Services (The revival of the 59-minute service to Hakone)

We are increasing direct services to Hakone to ensure a more comfortable and seamless travel experience.

2.1 New Daytime Services: Two new Limited Express Romancecar services will be added to the daytime schedule.

Train type	Destination
Sagami No. 50 (Inbound)	Hadano (11:25) → Shinjuku (12:28)
Hakone No. 61 (Outbound)	Shinjuku (12:40) → Hakone-Yumoto (14:08)

2.2 Expanded Service Routes: Three daytime Limited Express Romancecar services that previously started/ended at Odawara will now be extended to/from Hakone-Yumoto.

Train type	Destination
Hakone No. 72 (Inbound)	Hakone-Yumoto (11:07) → Shinjuku (12:46)
Hakone No. 29 (Outbound)	Shinjuku (16:20) → Hakone-Yumoto (17:58)
Hakone No. 26 (Inbound)	Hakone-Yumoto (18:13) → Shinjuku (19:45)

2.3 Additional Evening Stops: More stations will be served during evening hours.

2.4 Revival of 59-Minute Run: The "Super Hakone No. 5" Limited Express Romancecar
The 59-minute travel time from Shinjuku to Odawara will return after two years on the "Super Hakone No. 5" (departing Shinjuku at 9:00 AM).
