

Visit Tanzawa and Oyama by Limited Express Romancecar

The Romancecar has reserved seating only for travel to Isehara, and is fast and comfortable!

Additional limited express surcharge is required for the Romancecar.



If you have a Tanzawa/Oyama Freepass from Shinjuku, only the additional limited express surcharge of 750 yen is required.

Discounted excursion ticket Tanzawa / Oyama Freepass(A ticket), 2,520 yen from Shinjuku



750 yen (one way) for limited express surcharge between Shinjuku and Isehara

*You can save 50 yen if you use the Odakyu's digital ticket purchase website (EMot Online Tickets) to purchase your electronic limited express ticket

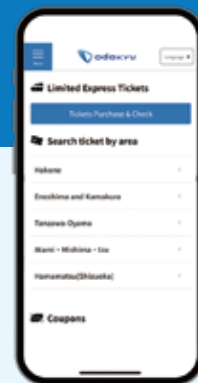

*EMot Online Tickets is available in English, Chinese (traditional and simplified), and Korean.

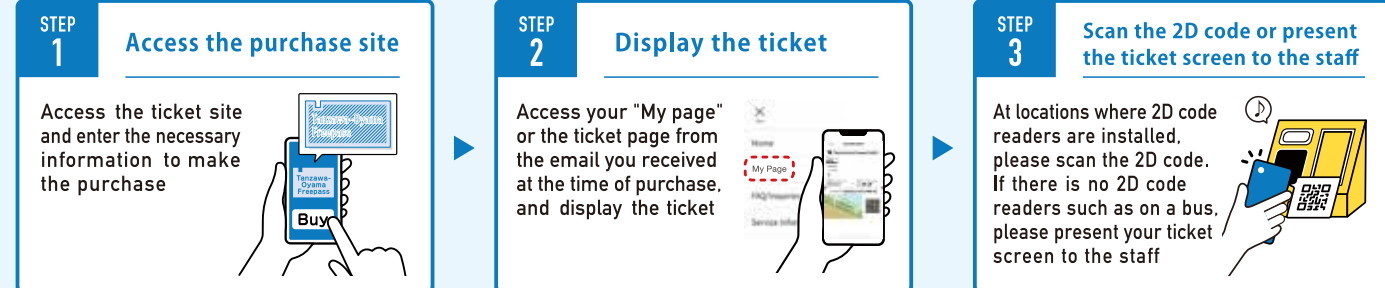
How to buy and use Limited Express Romancecar tickets

Click on "Tickets Purchase & Check" on the home page to book or purchase limited express tickets. Once you have purchased a digital limited express ticket, you do not need to change it for a paper ticket. You can use the digital ticket to travel with.

Important points to note : *Please use a smartphone to purchase limited express tickets (They cannot be purchased using a PC or tablet PC) *Limited express tickets can be purchased for up to 8 people at one time *You will need to enter your credit card details to purchase tickets



How to buy and use Digital Tanzawa/Oyama Freepass



Important points to note : *Please note that digital tickets cannot be used without the necessary communication environment (WiFi, etc.) *You will need one smartphone per person to use digital tickets (PCs and tablet PCs cannot be used for this) *If you do not have a smartphone, please purchase a paper ticket at an Odakyu Sightseeing Service Center or ticket vending machine

Enjoy strolling the mountain trails luxuriantly swathed in greenery, pilgrimages to historical shrines and temples, and the local cuisine of the mountain hamlets, among others. Enjoy a convenient, money-saving trip with Odakyu's Tanzawa/Oyama Freepass.

Convenient for a hike or stroll on Mt. Oyama!



★ The view from Oyama Afuri-jinja Shrine is awarded two Michelin stars in the revised 4th edition of the Michelin Green Guide Japan.

● Round-trip travel on the Odakyu Line + unlimited use of Odakyu Line (Hon-Atsugi⇄Shibusawa), Kanagawa Chuo Kotsu Bus (designated sections) and Oyama Cable Car (A Ticket only)!

*You cannot ride the Oyama Cable Car with a B Ticket.
*An additional fare is required if boarding outside of or traveling beyond designated sections.
● Does not include the Limited Express Romancecar surcharge. Please buy a limited express ticket if you use the Romancecar.
● Good for one round-trip on the Odakyu Line from the originating station to the destination station (Hon-Atsugi⇄Shibusawa).
● The Tanzawa/Oyama Freepass can be purchased starting one month prior to the date of travel.
● Showing your Tanzawa/Oyama Freepass entitles you to receive exclusives at designated stores on Oyama-sando.

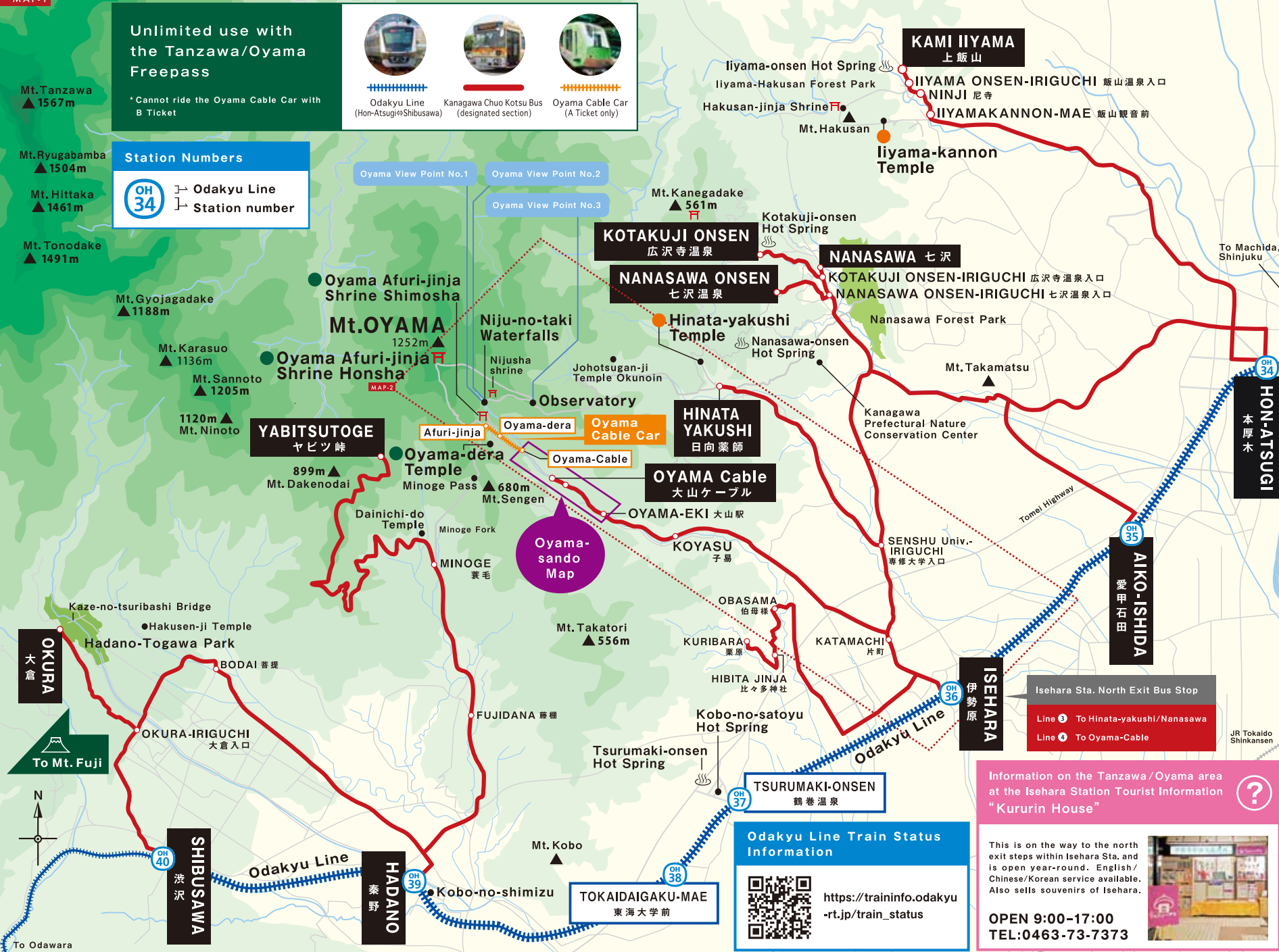

Recommended sightseeing spots in the Tanzawa-Oyama region

● Oyama Afuri-jinja Shrine

Founded in pre-Christian times. Jomon pottery thought to have been used in religious rituals has been excavated from the mountain top. Mt. Oyama is also known as "Amefuriyama" or mountain of abundant rain, and was a center for rainmaking rite beliefs since ancient times. It was also a worship site for Minamoto no Yoritomo (first shogun of the Kamakura shogunate in 1192) and successive generations of the Tokugawa shogunate (1603-1867). The Honsha, or main shrine, is at the peak and the Shimosha is on the slope of the mountain.

Mt. Fuji and Mt. Oyama

Oyamatsumi no Okami the deity to which the Oyama Afuri-jinja Shrine is dedicated teamed with "dual pilgrims" for Mt. Oyama and Mt. Fuji, as the deity is the father of Konohana no Sakuyahime, the goddess of Mt. Fuji.



● Hinata-yakushi Temple

Founded in 716. One of the three Japanese Hinata-yakushi healing Buddha. The principal hatchet-carved (*nata-bori*) image of the healing Buddha is a statue usually not on public view, but is open for viewing on January 1-3, January 8, and April 15. At the treasury, you can inspect votive images of Yakushi-nyorai, Amida-nyorai and Juuni-shinsho, the 12 guardian gods of Yakushi. It is a famous spot for plum and cherry blossoms in spring, and red spider lily in autumn.



Oyama Afuri-jinja Shrine Shimosha

● Oyama-dera Temple

Founded in 755 AD. The principal votive icon of Fudo-Myoo, the God of Fire, constructed in the Kamakura era, is unveiled on the 8th, 18th and 28th of each month. Affectionately called "Oyama-no-ofudo-san," it has been familiar since ancient times as one of the three great Fudos of the Kanto region. Kobo Daishi (774-835) served here in the Heian era (794-1192) and many historical relics associated with him can also be seen.

Famous autumnal foliage spot

Oyama-dera Temple is famous as a sightseeing spot for autumn foliage. The area around Oyama-sando street, the approach to the front of the main sanctuary, has particularly resplendent views of foliage.



● Iiyama-kannon Temple

Said to have its beginnings following construction by Minamoto no Yoritomo. The principle object of an 11-Headed Kannon is a small Buddha of 10 cm, and the 176cm 11-Headed Kannon is enshrined in the interior. It is known as a famous spot for cherry blossoms in spring and the best time to see it is when the blossoms form a tunnel over the path.
